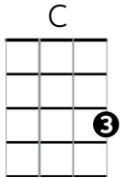

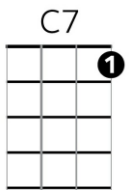
[C] = One sharp strum down.

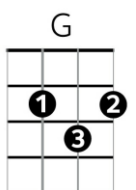
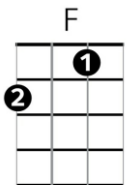
[NC] Well, it's a [C] one for the money, [C] two for the show
