

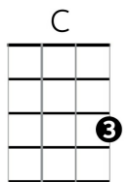

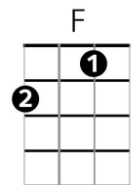

Intro: Dm 2 G7 4 | C F C 4 beats to bar

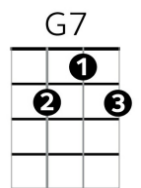
From a Jack to a [C] King, 2 3 4 | 1

and walked away with your [C] heart. 2 3 4 | 1



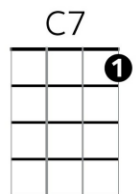
From a Jack to a King,

To make me King of your [C 2] heart. F 4 C



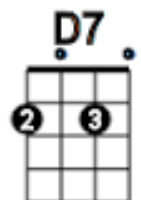
For [C7] just a [F] little while,

Then just in [D7] time I saw the twinkle in your [G7] eyes. 2 3 4 | 1



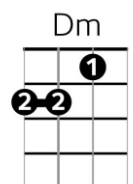
