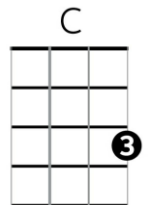
16th century traditional English

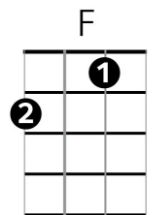
Count 6 x 1/2 beats = 1 & 2 & 3 &

Intro: (*Arpeggio*) Dm 2 3 | Dm 2 3 beats to bar

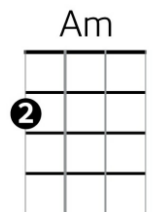
A-las my [F] love you [C] do me [Am] wrong

 De-[Dm]-lighting [A] in your [Dm] company.



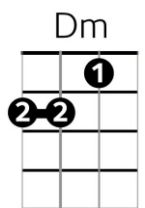
CHORUS: [F] Greensleeves was [C] all my [Am] joy;

 And [Dm] who but my [A] lady [Dm] Greensleeves?



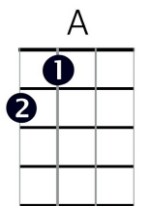
If [Dm] you in-[F]-tend thus [C] to dis-[Am]-tain,
