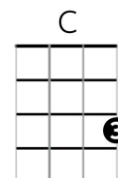

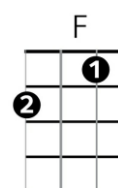

Intro: **D7** 2 3 4 | **C** 2 3 4 | **G7** 2 3 4 | **C** 2 3 4 4 beats to bar

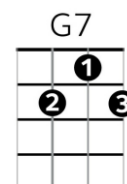
[C] Whenever I feel afraid,

So [C] no-one ever [G7] knows I'm a-[C]-fraid. 2 3 4 | 1 2 3

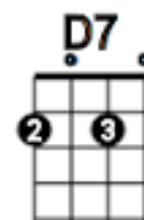


The [F] result of this deception
