C// | **Dm//** 3 beats to the bar

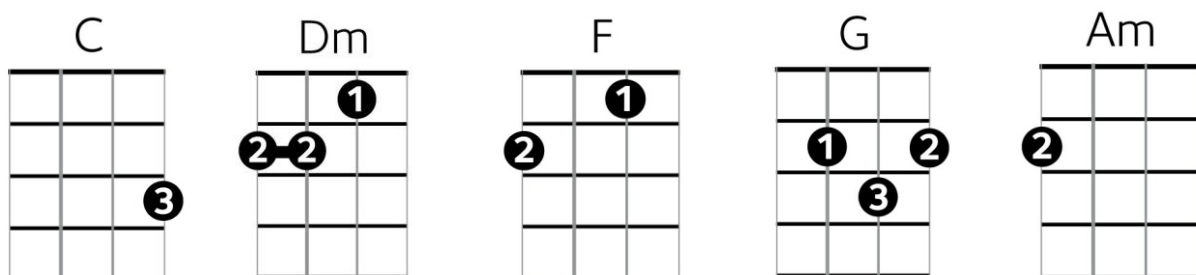
Are you going to [C] Scarborough [Dm] Fair?

Re-[Dm]-member [F] me to one who lives [C] there, ///
[Dm] She once [C] was a true love of [Dm] mine. ///

[Dm] Tell her to make me a [C] cambric [Dm] shirt,
[F] Parsley, [Dm] sage, [F] rose-[G]-mary and [Am] thyme //
With-[Dm]-out any [F] seam or needle-[C]-work, ///
[Dm] Then she'll [C] be a true love of [Dm] mine. ///

[Dm] Tell her to wash it in [C] yonder dry [Dm] well
[F] Parsley, [Dm] sage, [F] rose-[G]-mary and [Am] thyme //
Where [Dm] water ne'er [F] sprung, nor drop of rain [C] fell, ///
[Dm] Then she'll [C] be a true love of [Dm] mine. ///

[Dm] Tell her to dry it on [C] yonder [Dm] thorn
[F] Parsley, [Dm] sage, [F] rose-[G]-mary and [Am] thyme //
Which [Dm] ne'er bore blossom [F] since Adam was
[C] born, ///
[Dm] Then she'll [C] be a true love of [Dm] mine. ///

[Dm] Are you going to [C] Scarborough [Dm] Fair?
[F] Parsley, [Dm] sage, [F] rose-[G]-mary and [Am] thyme //
