

TABLATURE FINGERING EXERCISES C & G - Revised (musical notation can be disregarded)

NOTE: The fretting [LH] and fingering [RH] given below is standard Classical and is logical for playing tablature on soprano, concert and tenor ukuleles. Classical fingering is always recommended. Once mastered, classical fingering will promote fluent playing.

LEFT HAND FRETTING: numbers refer to both the fret number and the finger used to fret.

RIGHT HAND FINGERING: Number refers to the finger used to play the note.

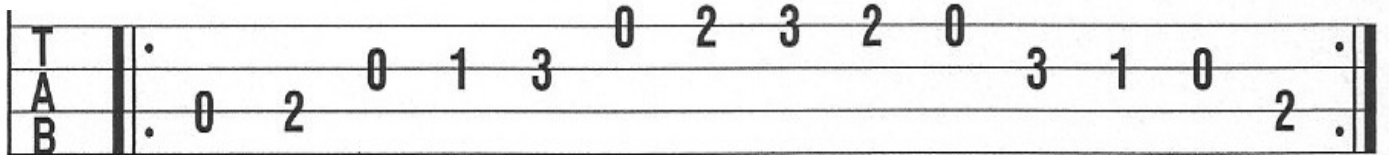
T (sometimes P) = Thumb; I = Index; M = middle; R = Ring; S (not used here) = Small



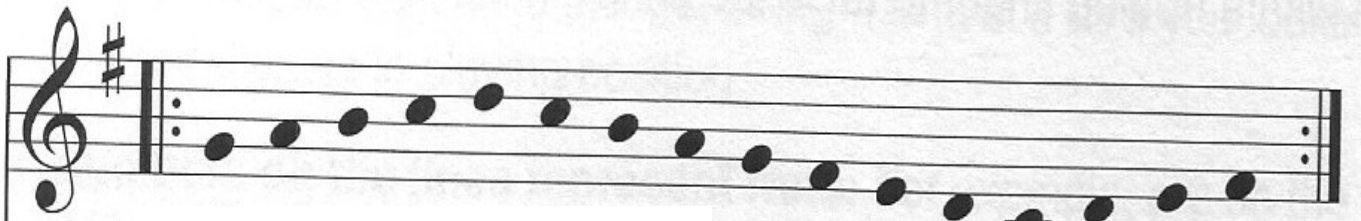

Left Hand Fretting



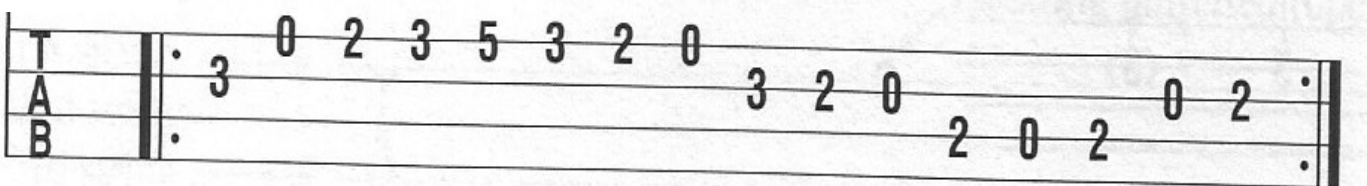
Right Hand Fingering T M T I R T M R M T R I T M
