
## The Four Ukulele Sizes

The most common ukulele sizes are SOPRANO, CONCERT, TENOR, and BARITONE. As you can see, soprano is the smallest and baritone is the biggest.



There isn't a universal standard for ukulele sizes. Most ukes will be close to the figures given above, but the actual measurements may vary slightly depending on the manufacturer. <u>Soprano, Concert, and Tenor Vs. Baritone</u>: **Soprano, concert**, and **tenor** ukes are all tuned the same way: **G-C-E-A**. This is known as standard tuning. The shared tuning of these three sizes means that if you learn to play on a soprano ukulele, you will also be able to play a concert or tenor. **Baritone** ukuleles have a different tuning: **D-G-B-E**. While this tuning has some similarities to the other sizes, it's still in its own category. Most ukulele music is intended for a soprano, concert, or tenor size ukulele.
